What To Expect & How To Prepare

ITC Malta is designed to help you meet new trade partners, build relationships and explore opportunities across the mobile, consumer electronics and IT components industries. This guide explains how the event works and how to make the most of your time.

HOW THE WEEK WORKS

Delegates arrive on Monday or Tuesday, with the main networking and exhibition activity taking place from Tuesday to Friday. Most delegates depart on Saturday.

The week combines structured meetings, open networking and social events, allowing you to build relationships in both business and relaxed settings.

MONDAY 08 JUNE 2026

Arrival

Delegates begin arriving throughout the day.

- ✓ Early arrivals often explore Malta or meet other delegates informally
- ✓ Pre-event registration and badge collection opens from 15:00 in the Hilton Lobby
- ✓ The evening is free for delegates to make their own dinner plans

Many delegates meet informally in the Hilton bars and restaurants or around Portomaso Marina.

TUESDAY 09 JUNE 2026

Arrival & Networking

The event begins at 10:30 on Tuesday.

Register at the ITC Registration desk in the Hilton Lobby on Level 5 to collect your badge, lanyard and ITC wristband. If you requested an ITC T-shirt, this can also be collected at this time.

Wristbands are required for access to the open bars. They are waterproof and should be worn throughout the event.

After registering, make your way to Merkanti Beach Club at the Hilton, where networking takes place throughout the day.

Expect:

- ✓ Informal networking
- ✓ Outdoor seating and poolside areas
- ✓ Lunch and refreshments
- ✓ Interactive networking activities
- ✓ Optional networking cruise with snorkelling

This is a relaxed day designed to help delegates meet each other before the main exhibition days begin.

In the evening, the Welcome Dinner takes place in the Oceana Restaurant at the Hilton.

Dress code: casual beachwear during the day and relaxed evening wear for dinner.

WEDNESDAY 10 JUNE 2026

Exhibition & Networking Dinner

Wednesday is the first full exhibition day at the Hilton Malta.

If you arrive after the ITC registration desk has closed on Tuesday, please go to the registration desk in the Hilton Lobby on Level 5 to collect your badge, lanyard and ITC wristband. If you requested an ITC T-shirt, you can also collect this at the same time.

Wristbands are required for access to the open bars. They are waterproof and should be worn throughout the event.

Collect your ITC Gift bag from outside the exhibition areas on Level 2 and Level 3.

Delegates spend the day:

- ✓ Visiting exhibition stands
- ✓ Meeting suppliers and buyers
- ✓ Networking in the exhibition areas and lounges

Lunch is served from 12:00 - 14:00 in the Oceana Restaurant on Level 3.

In the evening, transport is provided to the Networking Dinner at Café del Mar in St Paul's Bay from outside the Hilton Lobby. Collection also available from partner hotels.

Dress code: blue and white theme for Networking Dinner.

Return transport to the Hilton is provided. Drop offs at partner hotels will also be available.

THURSDAY 11 JUNE 2026

Exhibition & Industry Dinner

Meetings continue throughout the day in the exhibition and networking areas at the Hilton.

In the evening, the Industry Dinner takes place at La Valette Hall at the Mediterranean Conference Centre (MCC) in Valletta.

Dress code: smart evening wear; black and red theme for Industry Dinner.

Transport to and from the venue is provided from outside the Hilton Lobby. Collection and drop off also available from partner hotels.

Optional late-night networking continues afterwards at Infinity by Hugo's in St Julian's.

FRIDAY 12 JUNE 2026

Final Meetings & Networking Finale

Friday morning is the final opportunity to meet companies in the exhibition areas.

In the afternoon the event moves to a relaxed closing networking venue, Manta Beach Club in Sliema.

This final networking session gives delegates the opportunity to continue conversations from earlier in the week in a more informal setting before departures.

Transport to and from the venue is provided.

The finale includes:

- ✓ Relaxed networking
- ✓ Beach club setting
- ✓ Food and drinks
- ✓ Swimming and outdoor seating

Dress code: casual beachwear.

Transport to and from the venue is provided from outside the Hilton Lobby. Collection and drop off also available from partner hotels.

Many delegates consider this one of the most enjoyable parts of the week, providing a chance to relax and continue conversations after a busy event.

SATURDAY 13 JUNE 2026

Departure

Most delegates depart Malta on Saturday.

Before You Travel

Check your profile in the ITC Directory

Before arriving, make sure your ITC Directory profile is up to date. This helps other delegates understand who you are and what your company does. Add:

- ✓ A clear company description
- ✓ Your role
- ✓ Product categories you trade in
- ✓ Contact information; especially your WhatsApp number so delegates can contact you directly from the Online Directory
- ✓ A profile photo so delegates can recognise you

A strong profile makes it easier for other delegates to connect with you before and during the event.

The online directory opens for viewing on 5th May 2026.

To be included in the printed ITC Delegates Directory, all information should be updated by 17th May 2026.

Schedule Meetings

To get the most out of the event, many delegates review the attendee list in advance and arrange meetings before arriving in Malta.

The online directory opens for viewing on 5th May 2026.

You can:

- ✔ Contact companies through the directory via WhatsApp or Teams
- ✔ Schedule meetings through the online directory

Meetings usually take place at exhibitor stands, in the Networking Lounge, or in other designated seating areas around the venue. When arranging a meeting, agree a stand number or specific location. Some tables across the venue are numbered and can be used to schedule meetings in set time slots, making it easier to find each other.

However, the event is also designed for informal networking and spontaneous meetings, so do not worry if your schedule is not full before arrival. Many delegates prefer to keep time free to meet new contacts.

If someone does not arrive for a meeting, it is often because they are unsure where to find you. The easiest solution is to contact them through the online directory or WhatsApp to confirm the meeting location.

What To Bring

We recommend bringing:

- ✔ Business cards
- ✔ A portable power bank
- ✔ Comfortable footwear for walking between networking areas and venues
- ✔ Light clothing suitable for warm weather
- ✔ Swimwear and a hat for outdoor activities
- ✔ A power adaptor if your plug type is not compatible with Malta's UK style Type G sockets

Temperatures in Malta during June typically range between 25°C and 32°C, with strong sunshine during the day.

Morning Yoga Sessions

Optional morning yoga sessions take place each day from Tuesday to Friday between 07:00 and 08:00, adjacent to the Aqua Bar outside at the Hilton.

These sessions are open to all delegates and are a relaxed way to start the day before the networking programme begins. Mats are provided and spaces are limited.

WhatsApp Group

A dedicated WhatsApp group is created for registered delegates to help share information and announcements during the event.

Registered delegates are added to the group before it opens, usually around two weeks before the event.

The group is used for important updates, reminders and useful information throughout the week.

Arriving In Malta

Many delegates arrive before the event begins. Early arrivals often take the opportunity to explore Malta or meet other delegates informally.

The Hilton Malta bars and restaurants, along with the nearby Portomaso Marina, naturally become informal meeting points before the event officially begins.

Pre-event registration and badge collection opens on Monday from 15:00.

If you arrive early, there are several restaurants and bars within walking distance of the Hilton which we have listed here, along with some further afield:

Event Registration

Registration takes place in the Hilton Malta Lobby on Level 5.

At registration you will receive:

- ✓ Your delegate badge and lanyard
- ✓ An event map showing the exhibition areas, networking spaces and key locations within the Hilton and offsite venues
- ✓ Your ITC T-shirt (if you requested one)
- ✓ An ITC wristband used to access networking venues and open bars

Wristbands are required for access to the open bars. They are waterproof and should be worn throughout the event.

Cloakroom facilities are available in the Portomaso Foyer on Level 3 during the exhibition days for coats, bags and luggage.

If you arrive later in the week, simply visit the registration desk to collect your badge and event information.

We recommend collecting your badge as early as possible to avoid queuing.

WiFi access is available throughout the Hilton event areas and connection details can be found on the event map.

ITC Delegates Directory

The printed ITC Delegates Directory includes all attending companies, exhibitor and sponsor listings and key contact information.

Many delegates use this as a quick reference during the week to identify potential trading partners. The online directory is updated in real time and can be accessed before (from 5th May), during the event to book meetings and view your schedule and for 2 weeks after the event. The online directory includes contact details for all delegates.

How ITC Works

ITC Malta combines exhibition spaces, networking events and informal meeting areas.

The event is designed so you can:

- ✓ Walk around the exhibition areas and meet suppliers and buyers
- ✓ Arrange meetings in advance
- ✓ Join networking events throughout the week
- ✓ Continue discussions in informal settings

While the exhibition areas are central to the event, many conversations also happen in lounges, restaurants and at social events.

Some of the most valuable connections are often made through informal conversations during the week.

ITC is designed to encourage open networking, so delegates are welcome to introduce themselves and start conversations throughout the event.

Networking & Exhibition Areas

EXHIBITION AREAS

The exhibition spaces are located across two floors of the Hilton Malta. Key areas include:

New Mobiles, Accessories and Parts

Portomaso Foyer, Level 3

Used Electronics and Device Lifecycle Solutions

Portomaso Suite, Level 3

Consumer Electronics and IT

Business Centre, Level 2

Even if you already have meetings scheduled, it is worth walking around the exhibition areas as you may discover companies you were not previously aware of.

NETWORKING LOUNGE

The ITC Networking Lounge is located in the Quarterdeck Bar, Level 4 and provides a relaxed seating area where delegates can hold informal meetings throughout the event. Many delegates use this space to continue discussions after visiting the exhibition areas.

LUNCH & REFRESHMENTS

Lunch is served from 12:00 - 14:00 in the Oceana Restaurant and is included with your delegate ticket.

Lunch areas are clearly signposted within the Hilton from the exhibition areas and are often used for informal meetings.

DRINKS & BARS

Networking events throughout the week include open bars for delegates. Your ITC wristband enables bar staff to identify you as part of the event and access the hosted bars.

Tea, coffee and soft drinks are available all day across the venue, including a barista station on Level 2 in the New CE & IT exhibition area.

Some premium drinks may be chargeable. Bars within the Hilton operate as standard hotel bars unless used for ITC networking, meaning some may be open during daytime sessions but revert to standard service at other times.

Getting To Evening Venues

Some networking events take place offsite (away from the Hilton).

Transport is organised for delegates staying at the Hilton and partner hotels. Details of transport times and pickup locations will be shared during the event and will also be available at the registration desk.

Taxis and ride sharing services are widely available in Malta if you prefer to travel independently. We have listed some of these for you on our website:

Friday afternoon: Relaxed casual wear
